

Section 304. Softball

304.1 SPECIFICS.

- A. See General Rules, Section 1.
- B. American Softball Association slow-pitch rules will be applicable.
- C. Each regional winner is automatically eligible for the state competition. It is assumed that each region will conduct its own runoff.
- D. Ten men will constitute a full team. A team cannot play with fewer than nine members.
- E. Uniforms are not required, but in keeping with the DeMolay ideal of cleanliness and neatness, uniforms or similar dress are encouraged.
- F. Street shoes, tennis shoes or non-metal spikes are permitted. Metal cleats and bare feet are NOT permitted.
- G. Seven innings or 1 hour will be played to constitute a complete game. Teams tied at the end of seven innings will continue until the tie is broken.
- H. The games will be under the supervision and control of two umpires provided by the host region with approval of the State Director of Competitions.
- I. Each regional winner will supply two new restricted flight softballs for the state competition.
