Applicants may re-apply in different years.

Requirements:

All applicants must fully complete the attached application and to complete an essay in less than 500 words to one of the writing prompts.

- Take a minute and think about the things that you want to change.
- If you could start your own charity, what would your mission be? Who would you serve? What kinds of acts of service would volunteers perform?

Additionally, all applicants must demonstrate a well-rounded resume that exemplifies service, provide official/unofficial high school and/or college transcripts, & two (2) letters of recommendations from a counselor, professor, or employer.

The important thing to remember, all applicants are required to write a semester or yearly letter with an update of your personal, professional, and academic achievement. Additionally, please provide a copy of your grades.
